

OSU Wrestling Camps Frequently Asked Questions

1. **Can I choose my roommate?** Yes. Roommates are assigned at check in. When you leave the check in table and go to the table to pick up your key and meal card, tell them who you want to room with. It is easiest if your buddy is with you.
2. **Do we have a session Sunday night?** Yes. It is mostly to let you know the rules and general flow of the camp.
3. **What time are the technique campers done on Thursday?** There is a single elimination tournament that starts at 9 am. After you win/lose, you are free to go.
4. **Can parents attend the camps/tournament?** Yes, parents are welcome to watch any of the sessions they want, including the tournament.
5. **What time are the intensive campers done on Friday?** Friday morning consists of a LONG run. As soon as you complete this, you are free to go. If your travel arrangements require you to leave early, we can schedule your run for the night before if needed.
6. **Where do I need to go for the airport shuttle?** You need to wait in the baggage claim area. Due to airport security, the camp staff cannot enter the terminal to look for you. If for some reason you cannot locate our driver (they will have on OSU shirts), or he cannot locate you, he will have you paged. **DO NOT LEAVE BAGGAGE CLAIM!** If you need assistance, call Mark Perry at 405.269.1962.
7. **What is the fee for the shuttle?** In Stillwater, the fee is \$25 and must be paid to the driver. In Reno it is \$10 and must be paid to the driver. It is an NCAA rule that we collect this fee.
8. **Is there a laundry facility on site?** Yes, there is a coin operated laundry facility.
9. **What is a “commuter”?** A commuter is a camper who is not staying in the dorms. Commuters are generally local kids or kids who for whatever reason will be staying off site. The commuter fee does NOT include any meals.
10. **When do meals begin/end?** Meals begin with BREAKFAST on MONDAY, and end with BREAKFAST on the last day of camp. There will be pizza for sale in the dorm lobby each evening after the sessions are done, and the camp store also has snacks, as well as vending machines in the dorm.

11. **Do I need to bring a singlet?** We do not require you to wear a singlet, shorts and t shirt are acceptable, but some boys prefer to wear a singlet.
12. **What is available in the camp store?** There are items for sale such as snacks, drinks, souvenirs, shorts and t shirts.
